RE: Sportsmanship Committee Selection Process

The MAC Sportsmanship Committee have decided that the final decision as to who has earned a sportsmanship nomination, should come from “both” the coaching staff and their players.

The process will start with the coaches meeting with their team “prior” to the first league contest. At this meeting, both coaches and players will review “who” is in their division and exactly “what” the sportsmanship criterion consists of in determining the “sportsmanship winner.”

After the last divisional contest, the coach and the players will meet briefly to choose the team in their division that they feel best personifies “good sportsmanship.” The selected team’s name will be given to each school’s Athletic Director to be input electronically to the MAC Sportsmanship Committee for recognition. You must provide a reason or two as to what set that team apart from the others on the ballot, it will be passed on to all athletic directors and coaches. This will help aid in the learning process for all of us, as well as to help our league become one of the best in the state in the arena of sportsmanship.
